3. No wood working kits in this department (allowed in Dept 18 - Cultural Arts)
4. The quality of the finish will be considered as part of the workmanship in the evaluation and judging.
5. All posters to be no smaller than 11 x 14" or larger than 14 x 22."
6. Name of the article, use of the article, where it was made, species of wood, type of finish, exhibitor's contribution explained used on a 3x5" index card attached to lot.
