Regular or Danish Judging System

CATS

1. This exhibit is open to all participants who have selected, fed, and kept an accurate record of the animals entered for exhibition according to requirements of the organizations to which they belong.
2. Exhibitors may exhibit up to two (2) animals, with a limit of one per premium number.
3. Cats must be under the daily care, feeding and supervision of the exhibitor.
4. No nursing or pregnant cats will be allowed to exhibit.
5. All cats must be vaccinated for rabies and distemper at least 3 weeks prior to the show.
6. Kittens must be at least 4 months old at show time.
7. Kittens under 6 month will not be required to have rabies vaccination.
8. No cat showing signs of fleas, ear mites or other illness will be admitted.
9. Cats must be brought to the fair in a pet carrier or travel cage and be on a leash at all times.
10. Exhibitors must furnish their own food, water and equipment and must care for their animals while at the fair.
11. No adult whole males will be shown.
12. Judging will include general appearance, condition, temperament, proper handling, hair coat, paws, nails, body build and responses to questions.
13. Exhibitor must comply with all Wisconsin State Animal Health Regulations and testing requirements.

Class B – Short Hair Cats – Short hair, less than one inch
