Class A – Exploring

Lot Numbers, Class A:

- 1. Simple electricity project.
- 2. Simple food exhibit (box or mix type), 3 ona plate.
- 3. Plate of vegetables (all one type of vegetable), 5 on a plate.
- 4. Garden box of 5 vegetables. Your 12x14x3 inch box should contain 5 different vegetables you have grown, any number of each, arranged in an attractive manner using standards that are common for other vegetable entries. You should decorate your box to show off your exhibit.
- 5. House plant or flower bouquet.
- 6. Simple woodworking project (birdhouse, feeder, etc).

- 7. Nature display (insects, leaves, flowers, etc.).
- 8. Simple craft project (plastic canvas, popsicle stick, etc.).
- 9. Simple clothing project.
- 10. Simple knitting or crocheting project.
- 11. Display or poster as part of project assignment photography display. Photos to be taken by exhibitor.
- 12. Simple quilting project, any item.
- 13. Treasure box.
- 14. Treasure list.
- 15. Scrapbook of 4-H.
- 16. Collage of 4-H projects of interest to me.
- 17. Complete member guide.
- 18. Any self-determined project not listed above.
