### Photography Exhibits

1. Exhibitor is required to carry project which he or she is exhibiting in their respective youth organization.
2. All photographs must be the result of the exhibitor's project work for the show year.
3. All pictures for each premium number must be mounted on one piece of sturdier tagboard no smaller than 11"x14" or larger than 14"x22". (no staples)
4. Entry tag MUST be placed in the upper right hand corner of the exhibit on the front.
5. Each picture must have a caption. (no stickers, or glitter on the poster)
6. Photographs will be judged on the basis of technical quality, composition, and storytelling ability.
7. Prints from the same negative, slide, or digital image cannot be used in more than one lot.
8. Must be original work!

Lot numbers, Class G:

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| 1. Video production depicting a family event (vacation, party, construction, project, etc.) Maximum length: 15 minutes. | 4. An exhibit describing the steps involved in setting up for a video production – include lighting, set, equipment (video and audio) considerations. |
| 2. Production depicting development of youth organization or cultural arts event. Max length: 15 min.                   | 5. A diagram of a video camera and recorder unit – include description of any special features available.   |
| 3. Production showing a community service project. Maximum length: 15 minutes.  | 6. Any self-determined project not listed above.  |
