Sheep Exhibits

1. This exhibit is open to all participants who have selected, fed and kept an accurate record of the animals entered for exhibition according to the requirements of the organization to which they belong.
2. Exhibitors may exhibit up to six (6) animals in this department, with a maximum of three (3) market animals.
3. One animal may be entered under breeding or market classes but not both.
4. Exhibitors may enter more than one breed.
5. Classes with fewer than 6 animals may be combined.
6. All Columbias, Corriedales, Rambouillets, and Targhees shall be shown with two inches of wool or less. All other breeds shall be completely shorn between 2 months and 2 weeks prior to the fair.
7. Immediately following animal release, exhibitors are required to remove decorations and help put pens away. Premiums will be withheld from any exhibitor who does not have their animal area properly cleaned on Sunday night at the close of the fair. Each Superintendent will instruct the exhibitors on what needs to be cleaned for each species
8. Exhibitors must comply with all Wisconsin State Animals Health Regulations and testing requirements (**this includes scrapies tags**).

**Premium Schedule - Class H - Market Class - All Breeds Competing:
Lots 1-3 Blue - \$5.00 * Red - \$4.00 * White - \$3.00 * Pink - \$2.00**

Lot numbers, Classes I: Lambs are to be born after December 15th of the previous year. Market Class Lambs will be split into light, medium and heavy weights. Weight will be determined at weigh-in.

1. Lamb - Ewe or Wether
2. Pen of Lamb(s) - (2)
3. Feeder Lamb - Wether or Ewe, less than Feeder Lamb - (Wether or Ewe, less than 90 pounds, can not be shown in breeding classes)

**Premium Schedule - Class I Carcass Class
Blue - \$6.00 * Red - \$5.00 * White - \$4.00 * Pink - \$3.00**

Lot numbers, Class K: An exhibitor may enter a market lamb shown in one of the above classes of the current fair, but each exhibitor is limited to a single entry in the carcass class. The market sheep sold will be the animal having the ultrasound done and will be judged in the carcass show. Any extra ultrasounds requested are at the exhibitors expense and will not be judged.
